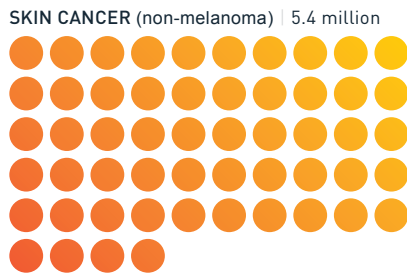


# DON'T FRY: PREVENTING SKIN CANCER

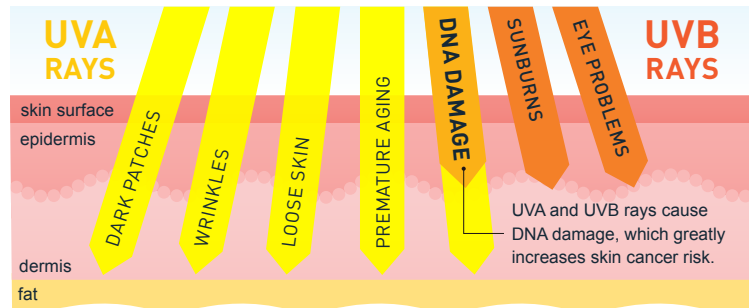
